



Iggle Piggle

Sc – Singel crochet
 Ch – Chain stitch
 Sl st – Slip stitch
 [x] – Round
 Inc – increase
 Dec – Decrease
 Sc2tog – crochet 2 sc together to one sc.

Legs (Pic 1)

Iggle Piggle makes some tinkeling sounds with his foot, and if you want to you can put a couple of bells in his foot, just when you stuff it. I forgot this and crocheted them in th blanket instead, make it as you want.

- [1] 6 sc in adjustable ring, red yarn.
- [2] Inc every sc – 12 sc, join round with sl st, make 1 ch.
- [3] Inc every sc – 24 sc, join round with sl st, make 1 ch.
- [4] Inc every 4th sc – 30 sc, join round with sl st.
- [5] Change color to blue and make 1 ch. Do not join rounds and 30 sc across.

[6-10] 30 sc

[11] Dec every 4th sc – 24 sc

[12-29] 24 sc

When both legs are 29 rounds each, join them together with 6 sl st, then continue to crochet around the legs, which then becomes the body. (pic 2+3) I got 37 sc round the body.

[30-45] 37 sc

[46] Dec every 12th sc – 34

[47-48] 34 sc

[49] Dec every 11th sc – 31 sc

[50-52] 31 sc

[53] Dec every other sc

[54] Dec every sc.

Now you should have a small hole to stuff legs and body.

When this is done, you either stitch the hole togheter or decrease until it is closed.

Arms

[1] 4 sc in adjustable ring, blue yarn.

[2] 4 sc, join round with sl st, make 1 ch

[3] Inc every other sc – 6 sc, join round with sl st, make 1 ch

[4] Inc every other sc – 10 sc, join round with sl st, 1 ch

[5] Inc every other sc – 15 sc – do NOT join round!

[6-9] 15 sc

[10] I put a chain to mark the transition from hand to arm

[description](#). Skip this if it seems difficult

[11-26] 15 sc

Stuff arms and attach to body.

Head

[1] 6 sc in adjustable ring.

[2] Inc in every sc – 12 sc

[3] Inc in every sc – 24 sc

[4] Inc in every 4th sc – 30 sc

[5-19] 30 sc

[20] Dec every 4th sc – 24 sc

[21] Dec in every sc – 12 sc

Stuff head, attach eyes (or embroid), stitch the holke together and attach to body. You can embroid a nose or just make a [puffstitch](#) somewhere in round 12 (or where you think it fits best)



Blanket

[1] Chain 21

[2] Start to crochet in the second sc from hook and crochet 20 sc in total. Chain 1 at the end, turn.

[3] 20 sc across and 2 ch at the end.

[4-14] 20 dc across and 2 ch at the end.

]15-16] 20 sc across and chain 1 at the end.

I put on 4 bells on the yarn and crocheted them into the blanket, Iggle Piggle makes som tinkeling sounds with his foot. On the edge of the blanket I crocheted with white threadthere is a white sewing on the edge of the blanket, but I made some single crochet instead and in every third stitch I made it over 3 rounds. I attached the blanket to one of the hands.

"Dots on head"

[1] 4 sc in adjustable ring, red yarn.

[2] 4 sc

Cut yarn and attach them on the head
